# Verdicts Jefferson County

Auto Negligence - A right of way collision resulted in a defense verdict - Defense p. 7

Medical Negligence - A pathologist and a family doctor were blamed for their handling of a slide taken in 1995 that was indicative of cancer – nothing was done at that time and eight years later the cancer had metastasized, the plaintiff dying two years later - Defense p. 8

Premises Liability - The plaintiff slipped on an uneven concrete joint and shattered her elbow - Defense p.

# **Trigg County**

Medical Negligence - The plaintiff died of a multi-drug toxicity overdose after being prescribed methadone at a family practice clinic – his estate was critical of using the drug before running a drug screen - \$818,000 p. 1

# **Fayette County**

Premises Liability - The plaintiff slipped on a flower petal at Kroger and sustained an ankle injury – this jury awarded significant special damages, but nothing for pain and suffering - \$210,629 p. 3

#### **Boyd County**

Medical Negligence - The plaintiff linked bacterial spinal meningitis to a steroid injection her doctor administered without wearing a mask - Defense p. 4

#### **Bourbon County**

Will Contest/Wrongful Death - In an odd case the plaintiff alleged not only that his stepmother converted funds from his father's estate, but also that she poisoned him - Mixed verdict p. 4

#### Federal Court - Bowling Green

Prison Medical Negligence - A prisoner at a county jail died of alcohol withdrawal – his estate blamed his jailers and the jailhouse doctor for failing to institute a detox protocol to prevent his death - Defense p. 5

#### **Mercer County**

Medical Negligence - An out-of-town golfer presented to an ER with signs of a heart attack – the doctor diagnosed a muscle strain – the man was dead within hours of a aortic dissection - Defense p. 7

#### **Martin County**

Auto Negligence - While the plaintiff's driver pulled from a stop sign and into the defendant's path, the plaintiff argued the defendant was speeding - Defense p. 8

# **Kenton County**

Underinsured Motorist - A right of way collision left the plaintiff with a shoulder injury – she prevailed at trial and exceeded a \$50,000 floor of UIM coverage - \$97,546 p. 9

# **Hardin County**

Medical Negligence - A missionary to Africa contracted a disabling case of malaria – she blamed her doctor back at home for prescribing an inadequate anti-malarial medication scheme - Defense p. 10

### **Warren County**

Auto Negligence - The jury's verdict in a multi-car rearender was for the defendant - Defense p. 11
